RULES:

1. Flowers should be uniform in height, color, and size for judging.
2. Flowers should be prepared by soaking in deep pails of cold water several hours before the show.
3. Tin cans and unsightly containers will not be allowed. Exhibitors must furnish their own vases or baskets. Pots may not exceed 10 inches.
4. No foliage in water.
5. No artificial arrangements will be accepted.
6. Wire stems may not be used. May use clear cellophane.
7. The Denver Fair Committee will not be held responsible for any damage or loss. Maximum care of containers and accessories will be taken until they can be reclaimed by exhibitors at the close of the fair.
8. Except in arrangement classes, all entries must be grown by exhibitor.
9. **No registering for other people. Youth entering must be present when registering.**
10. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to correctly identify his/her plants or flowers & enter them in the correct classes. Any entry entered in the wrong class by the exhibitor will not be judged or reclassified at the time of judging.**
11. No plants entered in previous years.
12. Any entries with insects will be disqualified.

RULES: Apply To Sections 3 and 4

1. Exhibits in this division must be cut flowers grown by the exhibitor and must conform to the number of blooms, spikes or stems specified in each class.
2. The uniformity of height, color or size is an important factor in evaluating entries.

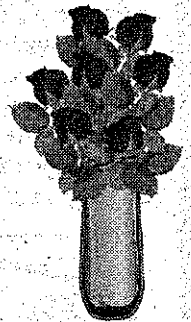

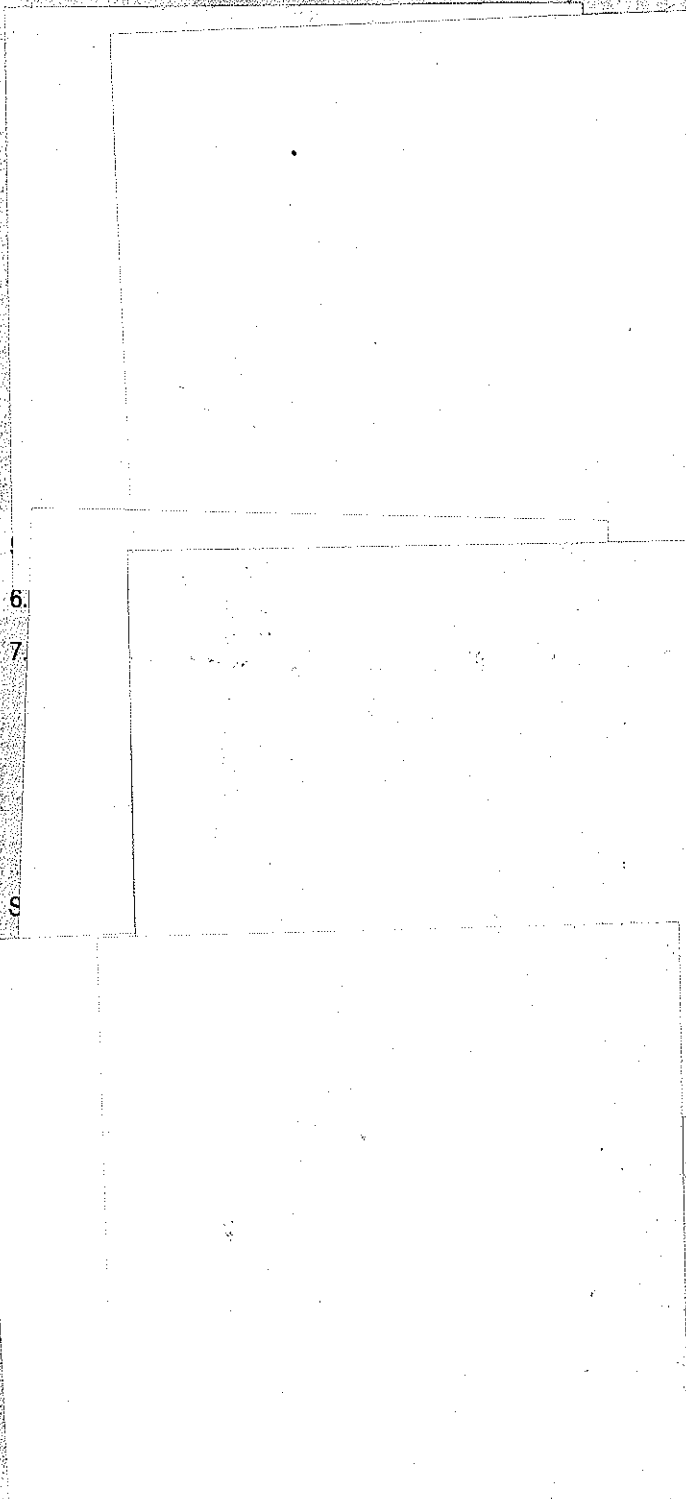
