- All items must be labeled at check-in, or prior, for a specific Class and Category below.
- No items requiring refrigeration will be accepted.
- All pans, plates, dishes are considered disposable and will not be returned.
- It is recommended to submit items on stiff plate and in plastic wrap or bag to retain freshness until judging.
- Entrants may be disqualified if item is categorized incorrectly, item is inedible or a class requirement is not met (i.e. quantity, size, etc.).

- Entrants may NOT have won 1st place in this Angel Food Cake contest at any other fair in 2021.
- Entry must be an Angel Food Cake made from "scratch." All ingredients
- and decorations must be edible.

  Pennsylvania produced & packed eggs are requested to be used, if possible.

  Please look for the PEQAP or PA packaging dates on the carton.

  The entire cake entry must be submitted for judging on cardboard or other food safe disposable setting. (All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.)

- Recipe(s) listing the ingredients and the preparation instructions must be submitted with the entry (printed on one side of 8½ x11" size paper). Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the back of all the pages. (All recipes and cakes will become the property of the Fair or PA Farm Show and will not be returned.)
- Refrigeration is NOT available at the Fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned, or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.
- Judging will be based on the following criteria:

Flavor (smell, taste, flavoring) 30 points Inside Characteristics (texture & lightness) Overall Appearance (surface, size, color) 25 points 20 points Creativity 15 points Topping, Icing or Decoration 10 points

## **DEPARTMENT 15** BLUE RIBBON APPLE PIE CONTEST



- Open to any individual amateur baker who is a Pennsylvania resident. One entry per person.
- Entrants may NOT have won 1st place in this Blue Ribbon Apple Pie contest at any other fair in 2021.
- Entry must be a pie that **must include at least 60% apples in the filling.** It does not need to be a "traditional" two crusted apple pie and it can have a variety of fillings. **All ingredients and decorations must be edible.**
- The entire pie must be submitted for judging in a food safe disposable pie pan. (All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.)

  The recipe for the pie and pie crust must be submitted with the entry. It should be submitted on one side of 8½ by 11° paper. The recipe must list all the ingredients, quantities and the preparation instructions. Entrant's name, address and phone number must be printed on the <u>back side</u> of all the pages. (All recipes and pies will become the property of the Fair or PA Farm Show and will <u>not</u> be returned.)
- Refrigeration is not available at the Fair or PA Farm Show. Entries that require refrigeration after baking must indicate so in the recipe. Those entries will not be sold, auctioned or otherwise distributed for consumption after judging for food safety reasons.
- Judging will be based on the following criteria:

30 points Filling: consistency, doneness, moistness & flavor 25 points 20 points Crust: color, flavor, texture doneness Overall Appearance 15 points Creativity 10 points TOTAL 100 Points

Creativity is essential to a varied competition. Do not limit your contest to a "traditional" two-crusted apple pie. We are looking for a variety of fillings in the pies; the pie must include at least 60% apples in the filling. The recipe for the pie and pie crust will also need to be submitted when entering at the Pennsylvania Farm Show. Each Fair must sign a Certification Entry Form verifying the winning apple pie baker, and this person will be eligible to enter the state competition at the 2022 Farm Show.

NOTE: If an individual has already won 1st place at another fair in 2021 for this Blue Ribbon Apple Pie contest, that individual is now considered qualified through that Fair to compete at the 2022 PA Farm Show and is no longer eligible to enter this contest at any upcoming Fairs.

First Place Winner is eligible for the 2022 PA Farm Show competition.
