- 1. The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture will once again conduct a statewide poster contest at the agricultural fairs. Participating fairs will hold their own contest and submit one poster from each age group to the state level for additional judging and cash prizes.
- 2. Exhibitor must be in one of the age groups as of June 1st of the current fair season to qualify.
- 3. Poster size must be either 14x22 inches or 14-1/2x22 inches. Other sizes will not be accepted.
- 4. Entry needs to use the current year fair theme of "Flour-ishing with Opportunity Rooted in Agriculture." Contestants are asked to submit artwork that highlights the deep roots of agriculture in Pennsylvania's history and the significant innovations farmers and their families have made and continue to make, to grow and adapt as markets, consumers and resources change.
- 5. Posters using another theme will be disqualified.
- 6. Posters will be evaluated on use of theme, visual appearance and creativity in relation to exhibitors age.
- 7. Premium checks from the State Contest will be: 1st place \$100, 2nd place \$75 and 3rd place \$50. These checks will be presented by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture to the top 3 individuals. Winners will be notified in advance and invited to attend an awards presentation. They will be required to provide their social security numbers for award disbursement.
- 8. All posters will become the property of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture for possible future promotional activities. Posters will not be returned.
