Goats will be housed in a provided location at Denver Memorial Park. The Market Goat show will consist of two shows:
preview market goats not to be sold & market goats to be sold. Show: Thursday, September 17, 2026 at 5:00 P.M.

RULES:

- Ownership** - All goats must be owned by the exhibitor by June 1, 2026. Goats must be shown by owner except when the owner has more than one entry per class.
- Eligibility** - Any youth aged between ages 6-21 is eligible to compete. Exhibitor will be listed by age as of January 1 of current year.
- There is a \$6.00 per head entry fee.** The Denver Fair reserves the right to limit space & quantity of entries. All local school districts will be considered first.
- Entries** - All entries must be submitted online through Showman.app (see page 18), where you can access entry forms, schedules and submit entry fee payments. Each exhibitors is allowed a maximum of four (4) market goats. All market goats must weigh between 50-120 pounds. There is a limit of (10) entries per exhibitor (Market or Breeding). Junior doe classes may not have freshened. Senior doe classes must have freshened at least one.
- Care** - Straw bedding will be provided by the Denver Fair Committee. Feed, feed pans, water buckets, hay and fans must be provided by the exhibitor who must see that animals are fed & cared for the duration of the ENTIRE fair. The Denver Fair Committee will provide a night watchperson to stay with the animals. Exhibitors will be held solely responsible for any loss, injury, or damage arising from any animals exhibited by him/her. **Each exhibitor is required to help clean up the livestock area after removing their animals on Friday night following the sale. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of premiums, at the discretion of the Livestock Chairman.**
- Health Requirements** - A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within 30 Days Prior to Check-In is required. The Denver Fair, 801 Main Street, Denver PA 17517 MUST be listed on the CVI. Entries showing clinical evidence of infectious, contagious, or parasitic disease or under quarantine for any disease shall not be admitted to the show. Official USDA scrapie animal ID is required. Official scrapie ID includes: USDA scrapie ear tag, USDA approved custom scrapie ear tag or USDA approved scrapie tattoo with individual animal ID or ISO compliant 15 digit ear tag. A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian for animals 3 months or age and older (observe appropriate slaughter withdrawal time) is strongly recommended. All drug & vaccine labels must be followed including withdrawal periods. Anyone using artificial means to change the condition, form or shape of an animal will be disqualified from all classes in which they have entries at the discretion of the Goat Show Committee.
- Time** - All goats must be checked in and in assigned stalls from 4:30 PM to 8:00 PM on Monday, September 14.
- Show** - Thursday, September 17, 2026 at 5:00 P.M. in the livestock show ring.
- Sale** - All market goats will be sold during the market livestock sale Friday, September 18 at 6:00 P.M.
- Non-sale livestock can leave Thursday night at 10:00 P.M. Please clean out your pen before leaving.
