RULES:

1. Canned food will be judged on quality, general appearance in container. Exhibitors should follow current recommendations from the National Center for Home Food Preservation (extension.psu.edu/food/preservation) or the USDA Complete Guide to Home Canning. High-acid foods (most fruits, pickles, jams and jellies) may be processed in a boiling-water canner or an atmospheric steam canner only when that method is specified in a current tested recipe; low-acid foods must be pressure canned using current tested guidelines.
2. Use standard Mason-type, clear quart/pint jars. No colored jars allowed. For jams, jellies, sauces or butter, use pint 8 oz. or 4 oz. clear jars.
3. Use two-piece self-sealing lids, flat discs and metal screw bands. Screw bands must be removed for showing.
4. All food not in standard jars or not sealed with self-sealing lids will not be accepted and will be disqualified by the judges.
5. Date and year canned, also contents of jar must appear on sealed lid in permanent marker. All entries must have been home-canned since the last Denver Fair (within approximately one year of the current fair dates).
6. Jars may be opened if there is a discrepancy between the judges.
7. Headspace for low-acid pressure canned items should be 1". For high-acid boiling water bath canned items, headspace should be 1/2". Headspace for jams, jellies and fruit butter should be 1/4". Ketchup should have 1/8" headspace.
8. Entries in "Other" classes, or products not listed by name, must follow a current, tested safe home-canning recipe from the National Center for Home Food Preservation, USDA, or Penn State Extension. Soups must follow a current, tested safe soup recipe, may not contain pasta, noodles, rice or dumplings, and must be pressure canned when required.
